

Terrace homes to be auctioned off plan

New terrace homes in Bateman near the Canning River are to be auctioned off-the-plan later this month.

Developed by LandCorp and CBI Inspired Lifestyles (a division of Cape Bouvard Investments), the Noalimba Terrace project consists of 36 two-storey terrace homes and will be 11km from Perth, 10 minutes from Fremantle and within walking distance of the Canning River.

Marketing and sales manager Greg Byrne said the spacious interior designs of the three and four-bedroom terrace homes had a contemporary influence.

"Noalimba Terraces are a refreshing alternative for those looking for a home encompassing sustainable practices," Mr Byrne said.

Prices are expected to reach around the high \$500,000 or low \$600,000 mark.

Stage One will see six homes auctioned on Monday evening, August 28.
